Workers at the GM protest site were greeted by top labour leaders on Sunday.

Early in the morning Ken Georgetti, President of the Canadian Labour Congress brought greetings and solidarity on behalf of the Congress' 3.2 million members. Ken was joined by CLC Secretary-Treasurer Hassan Yussuff.

Later in the day, CAW President Buzz Hargrove addressed the crowd in front of the General Motors headquarters building. Buzz was accompanied by a bus load of CAW national representatives, including many National Executive Board members.
