## **Informational Picket at Poletown,**

**Fri., May 2nd, 5:15am-6am, 1:45pm-2:30pm**

GM seems to be rotating assembly plants to try to keep production going. Can something be done about this? Yes, let's set up information picket lines at plants that are forced to run with scab parts and hand out a leaflet encouraging our fellow workers to work to rule and check for the upmost quality. This is perfectly legal because we are not asking them to shut down. We are just giving out information. We will call the NLRB office and inform them we will be distributing an informational leaflet getting their OK.

Poletown is back to work this week after having been shut down by the AAM strike. Besides asking for support for the AAM strike, we can also give them support for their struggle since they do not yet have a local agreement!

Let's go to Poletown on Fri., May 2nd, 5:15am-6am, 1:45pm-2:30pm.

Meet us at the Poletown east gate on the I-94 service drive by the overpass west of Mt. Elliott (park at the Dan & Vi store south of I-94 and cross at overpass).

Check with L. 235 on May 1st to see if Poletown has gone down due to another GM local strike.
