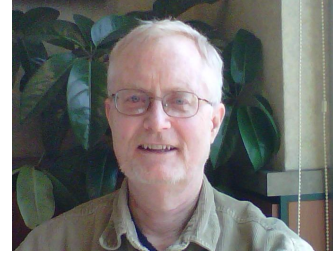

Ford is “doing well,” but **Mulally will make vicious take-back demands** for next year’s contract. **Will your officers stand up** to Ford and Solidarity House on concessions—or follow orders from “higher up”?

As sales increase, many workers hope for overtime. They can’t pay bills on 40 hours. But Ford wants to abuse “alternative work schedules” in order to add work AND reduce the workforce AND cut back overtime. **There is speedup in trades, not just in production!** The UAW must fight on many fronts—get more jobs, control work load, and win wages high enough that we don’t need overtime to live.

We need posted lists of outsourced work and outside contractors, so members can help “**watchdog**” the **subcontracting and outsourcing** that is bleeding union jobs away.

We welcome **UAW members from other Ford plants**. We’re all in this together.
