-- The union leadership should not have the right to re-open a contract and negotiate anything without first getting approval from the membership.

-- The union needs to let Ford know that, in the 2011 contract, we expect to get back ALL the raises, bonuses, COLA and break time that we have given up. Furthermore, the union needs to begin preparing now for a fight to get these things back.
